

Meet Mohamed, a brave nine-month-old who recently received cleft lip surgery at Asela Referral and Teaching Hospital. Born in the Oromia region of Ethiopia, Mohamed's parents, Ayat and Fatuma, travelled a long distance to seek treatment for their son.



Despite occasional cases of cleff lip and palate in their area, Fatuma was deeply worried about her child's condition. They registered Mohamed at a local health centre, patiently waiting for a solution.
